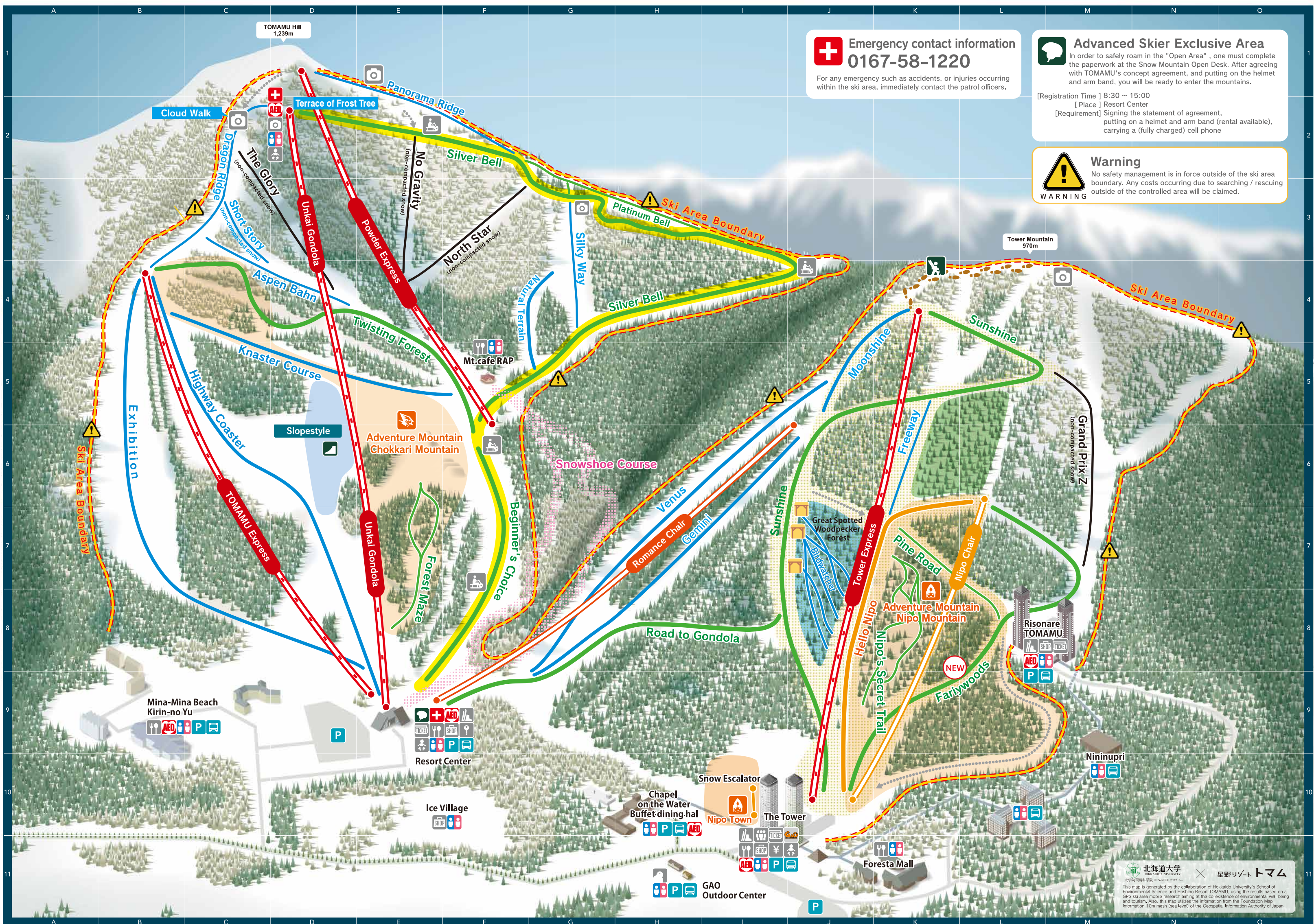


**Emergency contact information**
