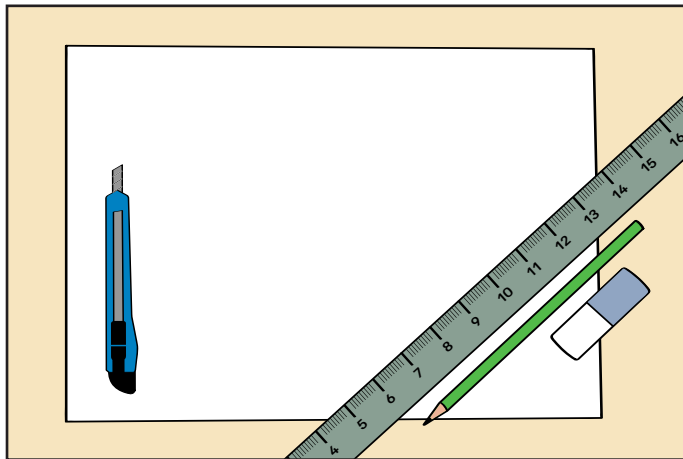
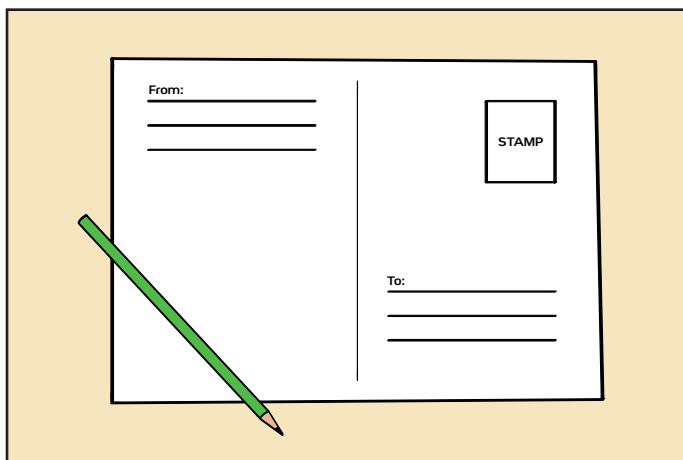


When was the last time you sent out snail mail?
Instead of going out to get some postcards, make some at home.

to recreate and send the postcard to a family or loved ones.



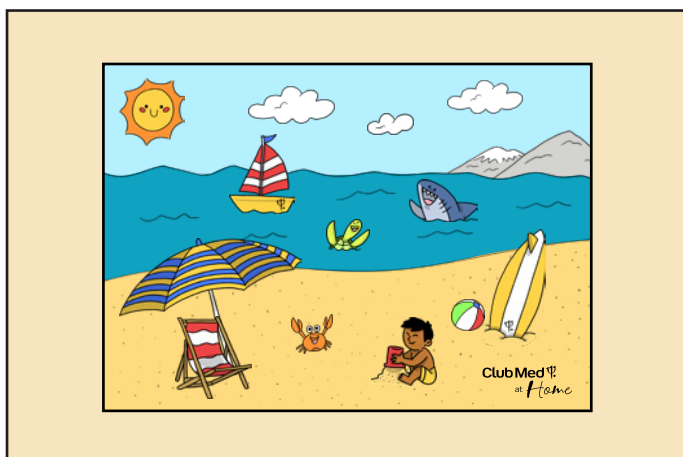
1. Making the card with sturdy paper.
To make sure your postcard won't get destroyed in the mail, choose a sturdy type of paper, like cardstock.
The postcard you make should be about the same thickness as a regular postcard.

2. Cut the paper to the right dimensions.
Take a ruler and measure out a card between **3 1/2** and **4 1/4** inches high and between **5** and **6** inches long.



3. Draw a line down the centre of the back.

4. Draw address line. On the right side of the center line, draw three horizontal lines. This is where you'll write the recipient's name and address. If you want, draw a box in the upper right hand corner where the stamp will go.



5. Decorate the card! Draw out scenes from your favourite Club Med vacation or print & colour the stickers from our "Get Creative" section and send the postcard to a family or loved ones.
