

Day 1 - Thursday
La Romana

Day 2 - Friday
Sailing on the open sea

Day 3 - Saturday
Aruba

Aruba is one of the Little West Indies islands, off the coast of Venezuela. Since it separated from the Dutch West Indies in 1986, it has been a State of the Kingdom of the Netherlands. It has little tropical vegetation, and white sand beaches that make it a hit with tourists. It is as flat as the Netherlands, the highest point on the island being Mount Jamanota, 18 metres high.

Day 4 - Sunday
Curaçao

On the largest of the ABC islands (Aruba, Bonaire and Curaçao), Willemstad is a little Caribbean Amsterdam vibrant with colour, blending Dutch and Spanish influences in its own original way. Ship docked at port.

Day 5 - Monday
Bonaire

This Dutch island is a real ecological sanctuary. It owes its reputation to its coral reef, amazing diving, and its flights of pink flamingoes. Ship docked in port.

Day 6 - Tuesday
Granada

This small island territory is home to fragrant nutmeg, cinnamon and vanilla. A succession of colonial influences has left a fascinating heritage of architectural curiosities. At anchor. No water.

Day 7 - Wednesday
Mayreau

The smallest of the Grenadine Islands has just one little village, surrounded by idyllic beaches with the finest sand, crystal clear waters and multicoloured tropical fish. At anchor. Beach and water sports. Inclusive of crayfish picnic.

Day 8 - Thursday
Le Marin

Tucked away in the corner of a bay, the market town dates back to colonial times. The Atlantic and the Caribbean Sea both lap at its shores. Drop anchor at this sailor's haven. Beach and water sports.

Day 9 - Friday
Pointe à Pitre

Spices, flowers, fish and fruit, the local markets abound with colour and exotic produce from this generous island paradise. Passengers boarding and disembarking at this port of call. Ship docked in port.

Excursions of your cruise

<p>Day 3 - Saturday Aruba / Submarine (1/2 day - afternoon) *</p>	<p>A unique opportunity to appreciate the wonders of the tropical waters. Dive as far as 50 metres below the surface of the deep blue sea in a high-tech submarine. Discover coral reefs (sea fans, sponges and more) and a whole host of different fish (angelfish, cofferfish, butterflyfish, surgeonfish and many others). The large portholes provide great views. If you tend to feel claustrophobic, rest assured that there is plenty of room, excellent lighting and good ventilation.</p>
<p>Day 3 - Saturday Aruba / Best of Aruba (1/2 day-morning) *</p>	<p>This stunning tour of the island shows you the very best of Aruba, appreciating both its natural wonders and its architecture through its most iconic sights. You will pass through the island's capital, Oranjestad, and admire the brightly coloured buildings, before setting off for the Casigari rock formations and the coral bridge. You'll finish your tour at the California Lighthouse, so you can enjoy the panoramic view that encompasses most of the island.</p>
<p>Day 4 - Sunday Curacao / The colors of Curacao (1/2 day-morning) *</p>	<p>Discover Willemstad, the capital of Curacao, on foot and by trolley train. Feast your eyes on the brightly coloured architecture of the UNESCO World Heritage Site city centre. Return to the ship at your own pace.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Monday Bonaire / Sail and Snorkel (1/2 day) *</p>	<p>A unique opportunity to experience the joys of sailing as a small group. Take to the waves on a 13 metre single-hull boat, and see the underwater wonders of Bonaire's sparkling clear waters. After your swim, a refreshing aperitif rounds off the boat trip wonderfully.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Monday Bonaire / Island tour (1/2 day - morning) *</p>	<p>The island of Bonaire is one of the most charming of the former Dutch Antilles! After travelling through the capital Kralendijk, a pretty little pastel-coloured town, you'll take the coast road north. You'll see Lake Goto, a natural saltwater lake that's popular with flamingos. Then you'll continue on to Rincon village, founded by the Spanish in the 14th century, and then head South to see the salt pans and former slave houses.</p>
<p>Day 6 - Tuesday Grenada / Forts and beaches (1/2 day - afternoon) *</p>	<p>You'll discover St Georges - the charming capital, known as the Little San Francisco of the West Indies - in a vintage truck. You'll stop at the two forts that look out over the town, and after a detour in the nearby hills, where you'll have a great view of the interior of the island, you'll have the chance to swim from one of Grenada's most beautiful beaches.</p>
<p>Day 6 - Tuesday Grenade / Catamaran coucher soleil (1/2 journée - après-midi) *</p>	
<p>Day 6 - Tuesday Grenade / Seafari Zodiac (1/2 day)</p>	<p>Service only available on board. Discover the Caribbean coast of Grenada at the helm of a speedboat for two people. You can explore the marine park where you will enjoy a snorkelling session on the very spot where Jason de Cayres Taylor submerged his now world-famous sculptures.</p>
<p>Day 7 - Wednesday Mayreau / Catamaran Tobago Cays (1/2 day) *</p>	<p>Sail around the stunning Tobago Cays marine park on a beautiful catamaran. The park is home to one of the most beautiful coral reefs in the West Indies and is teeming with wildlife. Open your eyes wide and enjoy the beauty of the little islands, you might even come across one of the many sea turtles that live in the reef. The amazing spectacle is played out both above and below the surface of the water.</p>
<p>Day 8 - Thursday Le Marin / 4X4 Sud (1/2 journée, matin) *</p>	<p>Climb aboard a four-wheel drive vehicle and explore the southern part of the island on little country roads where you will be able to enjoy breathtaking views of the Caribbean and Atlantic coasts. Travel through the tropical forest of Montravail to the commune of Rivière-Pilote, birthplace of La Mauny rum distillery. This lush green valley benefits from a microclimate that is unique in Martinique, combined with black volcanic clay soil, resulting in sugar cane with an exceptionally high sugar content. After visiting the factory and the cellars, a tasting of the finest rums awaits you.</p>
<p>Day 9 - Friday Basse Terre - The Mamelle park (1/2 day - morning) *</p>	<p>A superb excursion to discover the fauna and flora in the north of the island: you'll visit the Cascade aux Ecrevisses and walk in the Parc des Mamelles animal park where, if you have a head for heights, you can do the canopy tour.</p>

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccines: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be transmitted by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is recommended. Pregnant women, who do not require constant medical attention, can access the boat on presentation of a medical certificate indicating the date of the term and certifying that the pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The cruise must be completed before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.
