



Decorate cards and notes

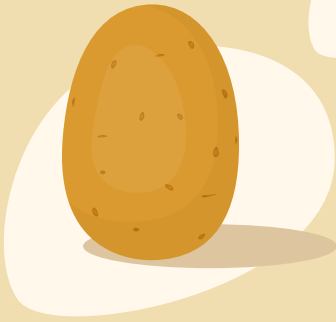
with a potato stamp.

You can use your stamp to decorate greeting cards and stationary to send letters to your friends or grandparents. A perfect activity that is a-peeling for the whole family!

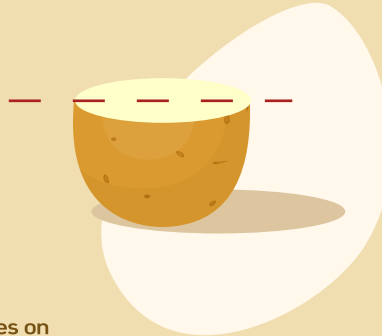


Step
01



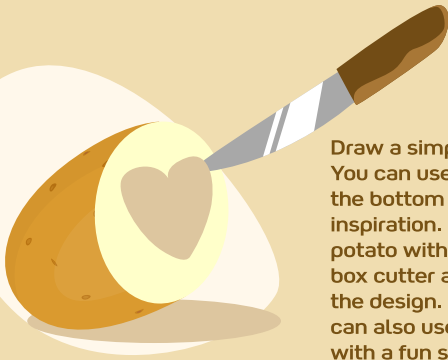
Head to the kitchen and look in the pantry for a nice potato. Choose one that is big enough to leave plenty of room for your design.

For the next three steps, ask an adult to help you use the knife. Cut your potato in half.

Draw a simple shape. You can use the examples on the bottom of the page for inspiration. Then, cut the potato with a small knife or box cutter along the lines of the design. Here's a tip: you can also use a cookie cutter with a fun shape to make things easier.

Finally, carve out the areas around the shape so that the shape sticks out approximately 1cm.

Your stamp is ready! You can apply the color of your choice by lightly dipping it in a bit of paint, or applying the paint with a brush.

Now, let your imagination run wild. Use your stamp to decorate a notebook, cards, or a sheet of paper. Mix colors and shapes to make designs inspired by your dream holidays. Or create a world of your own.
